I will always use and treat Central Catholic facilities and equipment with respect.
Before and after contests, I will meet and exchange cordial greetings to the set the correct tone for the event.
During the 2025 Moratorium Week, I will abide by the OSAA Board Policy #48. "There shall be no high school facility usage by administrators/coaches/directors/advisors and students, and no contact between administrator/coaches/directors/advisors and students." If I violate this policy, I will personally be responsible for the \$500 standard penalty fine and game suspension(s) may apply.
OSAA Ejections: If ejected from a sports contest, I will personally be responsible for all fines associated with my ejection, attend a sportsmanship training class and assist in submitting a Plan of Correction to the OSAA including timelines for implementation of the Plan. I understand and accept that a minimum of a 2 game/contest suspension will implemented.
Coach Certifications: I must complete all required certifications prior to the first sports practice including any individual training. I will not interact with student-athletes until all certification requirements are complete and turned into the Athletic Department. I will personally be responsible for all fines associated with expired certifications.
 Suspected Concussion Protocol: I acknowledge and agree to the following procedures: If a spinal injury is suspected or the athlete is unconscious, call 911 immediately. Non-emergency: I will remove athlete from participation/play. Athlete will be evaluated by highest trained coach or Athletic Trainer. Fill out Archdiocese Accident Report and provide a copy to both the AD and AT within 24 hours. Athlete will not participate in practices or games until the following has been completed: Secured medical clearance (OSAA Form) from athlete's doctor Successfully pass ImPACT test from CCHS Athletic Trainer Attend school full-time.
 Emergency Athletic Injuries: I agree to follow the below emergency injury procedures: Give first aid as needed, as determined by your level of training. Call 911, if deemed an emergency (airway, breathing, consciousness, severe pain, bleeding.) Contact parents. If athlete is transported by ambulance, a coach or designated adult must be on board. Notify Athletic Director and Athletic Trainer immediately (within 2 hours). Within 24 hrs., provide a copy of a Archdiocese Accident Report to both the AD and AT.
I agree that the failure to abide by these guidelines may result in a verbal warning by the Athletic Director, official, League Directors, dismissal from the facility, game forfeit, suspension and/or termination.
