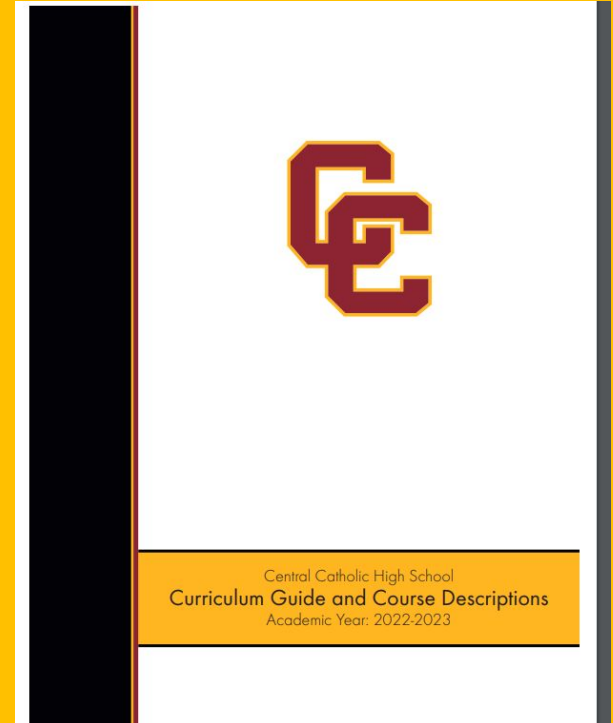

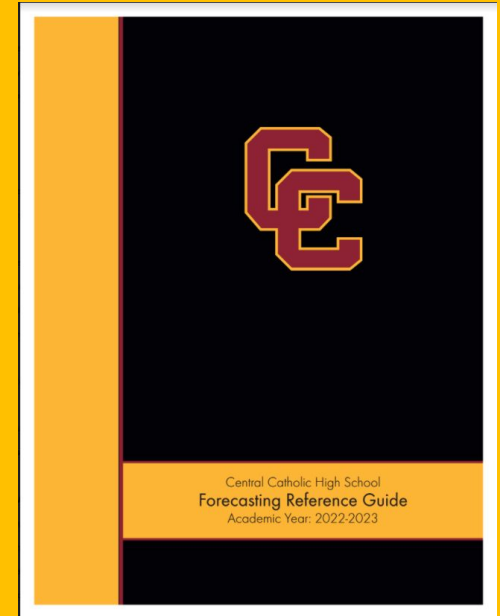

Graduation Requirements

- Theology 4 credits
- English 4 credits
- Social Science 3 credits
- Mathematics 3 credits
- Science (Lab) 3 credits
- World Language 2 credits
- Fine Arts 1 credit
- Computer Science .5 credit
- Wellness 1 credit
- Physical Education 1 credit



26 credits needed to graduate; 1 credit = 1 year (2 semesters); 0.5 credit = 1 semester

Oregon Public Universities

Students must achieve a grade of C- or better in the following areas:

4 years of **English**

3 years of **Mathematics** including Algebra I & Algebra II (or higher)

3 years of **Science**

3 years of **Social Studies** including:

- 1 year of US History
- 1 year of Global Studies
- 1 year of a Social Studies elective with Government strongly recommended.

2 years of the same **World Language** or one of the following:

- *C- or better in a third year of a world language
- *C- or better of a college level world language for two terms
- *Satisfactory performance on an approved assessment of a world language



Oregon Public Universities are test optional -- SAT and/or ACT scores are not required.

Fine Art Requirement for California Public Universities (UC or CSU colleges)

- 2 semesters: *same type* of art course required
- *Electronic Music qualifies as a fine art for California public colleges. Forecasting Video is incorrect when it says it does not.*

Pre-Assigned Placements

Talk to your teacher if unsure of your placement in core classes.



- Moving Honors/AP level → Regular level
(If you are preassigned an honors or AP level course and you want to move to a regular level - this is OK!)



- Moving from Regular Level → Honors/AP level
(If you are preassigned a regular level course and want to move to an Honors this needed to be pre-approved by your current teacher/applications etc.)

Step 3: Submitting your Choices

- Log into PowerSchool and submit your appropriate courses using your forecasting worksheet to help
- Download/save a copy or take a screenshot of your forecasting worksheet. Please have a parent or guardian review and sign it to confirm they are OK with your selections. Bring the completed and signed form to your counselor.



- **YOU MUST SUBMIT YOUR CHOICES IN POWER SCHOOL AND TURN YOUR WORKSHEET IN TO YOUR COUNSELOR BY MARCH 15th.**
- **Counselors will be coming into your Theology classes next week to meet with you 1:1 and help answer any questions or concerns.**

How to forecast for classes online

1. Power School Logins have been re-set and emailed to parents and students. If you need help with your log in information/password - please contact the main office (and ask them very nicely for assistance!!).

2. Portal will be live **Friday, March 3rd after school**

3. Portal will close on **Friday, March 15th at 3 PM**. All requests must be submitted by this deadline

4. Use your Forecasting Worksheet to know which courses to select in PowerSchool.

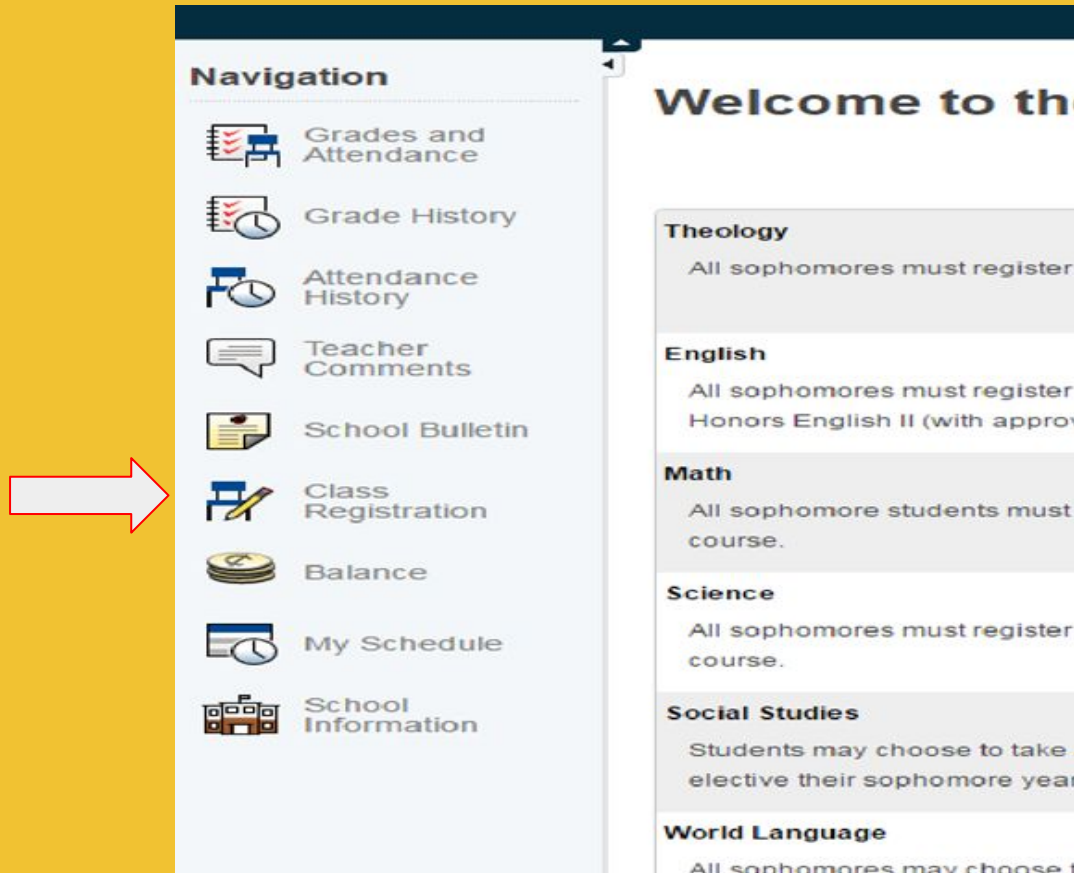
•Step 1: Go to **Central Catholic Website** – click on the **Forecasting Tab** - go to PowerSchool.


