



Oregon Public Universities

- Students must achieve a grade of C- or better in the following areas:
- 4 years of English
- 3 years of Mathematics including Algebra I & Algebra II (or higher)
- 3 years of Science
- 3 years of **Social Studies** including:
 - 1 year of US History
 - 1 year of Global Studies
 - 1 year of a Social Studies elective with Government strongly recommended.
- 2 years of the same **World Language** or one of the following:
 - *C- or better in a third year of a world language
 - *C- or better of a college level world language for two terms
 - *Satisfactory performance on an approved assessment of a world language











Oregon Public Universities are test optional -- SAT and/or ACT scores are not required.

Performing and Visual Art Requirement for California Public Universities (UC or CSU colleges)

- <u>2 semesters: same discipline required (music, theater, visual arts)</u>
- Electronic Music qualifies as this requirement for California public colleges.


