
2019-2020 Central Catholic Endowed Scholarship Application

Over the years, Central Catholic High School families and friends have generously made distinctive gifts to the school's Endowment Fund in order to provide scholarships for current students who meet specific criteria. Often, these scholarships are given in memory of a beloved family member who has passed away.

The scholarship committee considers all applicants for each scholarship we offer. All eligible students must:

- Demonstrate good citizenship at school and in the community
- Hold and maintain a minimum G.P.A. of 2.75
- Be up-to-date on service hours
- Be an active participant of the Central Catholic community (i.e. student activities, co-curriculars, student fundraiser)
- Turn in your completed application early or on time

Other requirements/restrictions:

- Many scholarships require some degree of financial need (see parent note below), while others are based solely on merit
- Individual scholarships may have different or additional criteria
- Students of current faculty and staff are not eligible to apply for scholarships
- Students who are on discipline probation when the application is due are not eligible for scholarships
- **No late applications will be accepted. Applications are due no later than 3:00 P.M. on January 9, 2019.**
- Applications must be neat and legible and all questions must be answered. **The committee takes these items into consideration when selecting scholarship recipients**
- Applicants must follow instructions

————— Application Process —————

Students:

Your application packet must include:

1. Application form (filled out neatly by the student)
2. One-page typed essay (written by the student) Please proof/spellcheck your essay.

Write a one-page (additional pages will not be read), typed (12 pt. font) and single-spaced essay on the following topic:

If you could "take a mulligan" and do over one thing in your life, what would it be? Why would you change what you did? What outcome would you hope to see? How might this affect you and those around you?

Parents:

Families that have not applied separately for financial aid will not be considered for scholarships requiring some degree of financial need. Financial aid forms are available on our website, in the Main Office, and Business Office. Completed forms must be postmarked to **FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment** by the February 16, 2019 deadline.

FACTS forms must be postmarked no later than the February 16, 2019 deadline for the applicant to qualify for scholarships requiring some degree of financial need.

Scholarship Applications are to be turned in to the Central Catholic Development Office no later than 3:00 P.M. Wednesday, January 9, 2019. Late applications will NOT be accepted. Scholarship recipients will be notified by mail mid-March.
