

Central Catholic Head Swim Coach

Central Catholic seeks an educator/coach who is committed to educating students from diverse backgrounds in a Catholic community, challenging each individual to live as a Christian witness in service to others. The Coach is an educator who understands and utilizes the value of interscholastic athletics as a mechanism for educating student-athletes.

Central Catholic believes that the program of interscholastic athletics is an integral part of the total educational structure. Although participation in the program of interscholastic athletics is voluntary, the individual is of prime importance.

Central Catholic believes that the coach of every athletic activity must assume a major role in the molding of youth in their charge. A coach should develop leaders, foster cooperation, and exhibit outstanding sportsmanship for emulation by students engaged in activities and/or as spectators. Coaches must insist upon sound academic pursuits, ethical behavior and good citizenship and should instill in the participants a desire to win with a display of moderate self-esteem in winning and minimal humiliation in losing. Coaches must serve as a role model in all of these qualities.

The primary aims for interscholastic athletics are the development of desirable traits in the individual, optimal participation, and fulfillment of competitive desires. Winning of championships should transpire as an outgrowth of ethical coaching and competition.

Essential job functions:

1. To instruct athletes in the fundamental skills, strategy and physical training necessary for them to realize a degree of individual and team success
2. To provide instruction that will lead to the formulation of moral values, strong work ethic, responsibility, team work, sportsmanship, self-discipline, leadership, and self-confidence

Duties and Responsibilities (all coaches):

1. Has a thorough knowledge of all school, conference league policies.
2. Attends all required meetings and submits all required paperwork in a timely manner
3. Maintains discipline and works to increase morale and cooperation within the school athletic program and school community
4. Completes all trainings
5. Supervises practices, games, and team trips
6. Completes required post-season forms
7. Communicates and works with athletic trainer
8. Maintains inventory of uniform/equipment issue

Duties and Responsibilities (Varsity Coaches):

1. Works with athletic director for scheduling
2. Organizes parents, coaches, and players for pre-season meetings
3. Participates in the budget process with the athletic director
4. Is accountable for all equipment and uniform issuance, collection, and storage
5. Maintains good public relations with media, Booster Club, volunteers
6. Establishes lettering criteria
7. Develops procedures for keeping parents and athletes informed
8. Establishes a policy with parents and players to address issues or concerns
9. Updates the athletic director frequently during season about any issues, concerns, or highlights
10. Schedules and plans a post-season awards night for specific sport

Qualifications:

1. ASEP/NFHS and Coaching Certification. (This can be completed after the hire)
2. Ability to organize and supervise a sports program/team
3. Preferred previous coaching experience in assigned sport
4. Knowledge of technical aspects of the assigned sport and willingness to continue to learn and examine new ideas pertinent to the assigned sport or coaching in general
5. Good role model

Special Requirements:

The person employed for these positions must be able to verify identity and employment authorization.

The candidates selected for these positions must complete a pre-employment background check and all Archdiocesan required trainings and certifications.
