Senior Graduation Survey

Last chance...There is still time for seniors to complete the online Graduation Survey in Naviance Student at <https://student.naviance.com/centralcatholic>; however, **it needs to be done before Monday (5/23)**. Once students are logged in, they will find the survey under the "Important To-Dos and Tasks" section.

The survey allows seniors to share their plans for next year, and lets us track college acceptances and admission data. Final transcripts will be sent to colleges based on this survey information.
